Greetings from Jeff Kistler!

We had a Zion's Reformed UCC Congregational Meeting on Sunday, July 10. Zion's congregation voted to authorize the sale of the building to Resurrected Life Community Church. Various details are still pending. We'll have a press conference/press release when details are finalized.

As I've shared before, Zion's Reformed UCC Congregational Life is concluding in 2022. There will be no services for the remainder of July and August, then services on the four Sundays in September, concluding with a final worship on Sunday, October 2, 2022 at 10:45 A.M.
