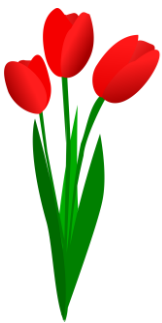

GREEN TEAM - Testimony

As someone who enjoys the beauty of nature and the aesthetic of city life, I want to bridge the gap between these two separate worlds in a way that doesn't harm the environment but still keeps that urban look. When Mrs. Nancy Kramer-Moyer spoke to the youth group about ways we can make a difference to the environment and brought books that gave us examples on how to do so a book stood out to me that paralleled my interests. It was called "Green Buildings," and it showed different examples of nature being incorporated into buildings, such as sustainable materials used to build homes and green roofs that insulated buildings. Green roofs stuck out to me because of their ecological benefits. Some of these benefits include: the ability to absorb carbon dioxide and improve air quality, reduce stormwater runoff, limit heat absorption in the summer, reduce the amount of energy needed to regulate building temperatures, and provide habitats for wildlife. I want to become an architect, but I also want to make a difference in my community and to the environment. Designing buildings that have green roofs will achieve my goal because it will help the environment and improve ecosystems, while saving energy and providing comfort to people in their homes. It will also enhance the urban look, as the added nature creates a clean and refreshing aesthetic to cities.
