Our Special Mission for February is Turning Point of the Lehigh Valley. For almost 50 years, Turning Point has been offering compassionate care and shelter for victims of Domestic Violence and Partner Abuse.

Unfortunately, the need has not significantly decreased over this period. In fact, Turning Point helped over 3500 Lehigh Valley residents in fiscal year 2021-22 and increased again to 3772 for fiscal year 2024-2025. St John's has supported Turning Point over the past years by donating money and items to support their Services and Shelter. This month we are asking you to continue this support by donating items on their Wish List (found on the Mission Bulletin Board in the Great Hall) and/or making a monetary contribution.
